

### **Intended Use of Equipment**

The MS Enclosure Bench 36 is intended to be a mobile bench enclosure designed exclusively for a SCIEX mass spectrometer (MS). A 0.75 inch thick phenolic resin countertop provides support to the MS.

The bench is supported by four heavy-duty leveling casters. The removable hinged door and removeable back panel give complete access to the inside of the enclosure. Locking slide-out tray assists the user in loading and unloading the roughing pumps (roughing pumps not included with this bench).

The internal lining of sound insulation foam dampens the noise of up to two roughing pumps. Two internal cooling fans keep the roughing pumps and the enclosure cool when the pumps are in operation. A green LED indicator on the front panel informs the status of the cooling fans.




#### **Front**




#### **Rear View**




### Interior of the Bench (Front door hidden)




## **Unpacking and Bench Installation**









**CAUTION** Check the packaging for any shipping damage before unpacking the bench. **Report any shipping damage to SCIEX.** Use a box cutter to carefully cut the pallet banding.



Lift the lid and the mid-section of the box. Cut the lower lid at the edges shown in red.




Lower the ramp at the hinges and roll the bench down gently. Follow the setup instructions to finish installation.






**CAUTION** Position the bench on a flat surface. This makes sure that the MS does not slide off the surface. Carefully place the MS on top of the bench.



Using a **flat-head screwdriver** rotate the lock clockwise and pull the door open. Follow the same procedure for removing the back panel if needed.



To load the roughing pumps, pull both the tabs shown in yellow simultaneously and extend the pullout tray. The tray will lock after it is fully extended. Load the roughing pumps carefully on the tray. Push the tabs simultaneously to retract the tray inside the bench until you hear a click.




**CAUTION** Load the MS and LC on the bench top before loading the pumps on the trays.


The total weight capacity of the MS Enclosure Bench 36 is **275.5 KGs**.




The weight capacity of the pull-out tray is **68 KGs**.

CAUTION Any weight being added on top of the bench and inside the bench SHOULD NOT exceed the weight capacity of the bench.






Complete the roughing pump connections to the MS using the instruction manuals provided with the MS. Pass hoses and cables through the four grommet-protected holes on the back of the bench. Remove the back panel for easier access.






**CAUTION** Roll the bench to the desired position. If the bench is positioned against a wall or any large object, it is recommended to position the bench at least 12" away from the wall or large object. This gives enough space for hot air to disperse. **DO NOT** position the bench in a closed-off location.





**WARNING** Once it is in position, level the bench by lowering the levelers. **The caster wheels SHOULD be completely off the ground as shown above.** This prevents the bench from rolling when in operation. Use a spirit level to level the bench horizontally.





To turn on the cooling fans, plug the power supply cable into the bulk head connector in the back as shown above. The green LED indicator on the front panel will light up to indicate that the power is on. **WARNING** Choose the appropriate power cord from the ones provided based on the region you are operating in.

### **Fuse Replacement**

The harness powering the fans and LED light comes with a replaceable automotive blade type fuse. The fuse is rated for 32V and 3A.




**WARNING** Make sure that the power supply is turned off and the power cables are disconnected before replacing the fuse.

In the rare case of a fuse failure, the damaged fuse can be replaced with a similar rated automotive blade fuse. To replace the fuse, use the following instructions:

- 1) Remove the back panel.
- 2) Take the foam out on the left side panel.
- 3) Find the fuse holder, and open the cap.







## **Cleaning**

Use clean soapy water to clean the outside surfaces of the bench and the countertop. Do not use harsh chemicals for cleaning.



**WARNING** Make sure that the power supply is turned off and the power cables are disconnected before cleaning.


# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Solutions
The cooling fans do not switch on after plugging in power.	Make sure the power supply is connected and the power is turned on.
	If the Green LED on the front panel is glowing, the fans are malfunctioning. Contact SCIEX.
	If the Green LED on the front panel is not on, check the fuse in the cable harness.
	Contact SCIEX.
The LED light does not switch on after plugging in power.	Make sure the power supply is connected and the power is turned on.
	If the cooling fans are running, the LED light is malfunctioning. Contact SCIEX.
	If the cooling fan is not running, check the fuse in the cable harness.
	Contact SCIEX.
